



### **Jumbo Treasure Sack**

Make a treasure sack from a paper bag and have the kids go on a treasure hunt for different items from around the campsite.

#### **Materials:**

- Paper Bag
- Crayons
- Stapler

#### **Instructions:**

Cut off a 4 inch strip around the top of the paper bag, this should now be a big loop. Cut the strip to make it one long strip and set it aside. Draw a design or picture on the side of the bag. Fold down the top edge of the paper bag about an inch. Fold the strip in half so you have a 2" wide strip and double thickness. Staple this onto the top, inside edge of the bag to make the strap. You may want to reinforce the stapled area with tape. Now you can go hunting for the treasure, just make sure your treasure isn't too heavy or the strap may rip.

Collecting things like pine cones or fallen leaves to make other crafts is a good idea for your treasure sack as they won't be too heavy.
