Cell phones using TDMA technology can no longer be reused (this includes emergency 911 services) but they can still be recycled! We want to ensure that cell phones are being recycled properly, so it is important to continue to send in the “old” phones to ensure they do not end up in our landfills or worse illegally dumped in our communities.

We will continue to compensate you for the older models however at a reduced rate of \$0.25 per cellular handset. Newer models will be compensated at the regular \$1.00 rate.
