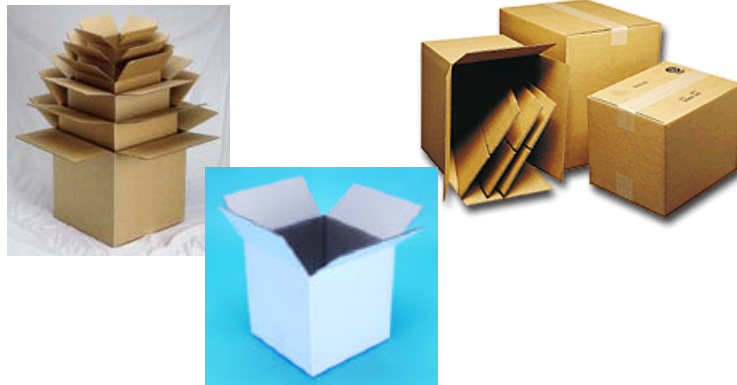


Cell Phone Collection Boxes & Containers

Collection Boxes

These can be made from any 'medium-sized' corrugated cardboard box:

- ❖ Large enough to hold at least two dozen phones (some suitable box dimensions would be about 18" wide x 18" deep x 12" high OR 12" wide x 12" deep x 18" high - for a smaller 'footprint')
- ❖ Strong enough to not break open when full (2 or 3 corrugations is better than 1)
- ❖ Tape the flaps on one end and leave the other end (the end you place on the counter or table) folded in order to retrieve the cell phones
- ❖ Cut a hole or slot in the top large enough to allow people to put in a cell phone but not so large that people will be able to take phones out of the box (opening should be about 2"x 4")



Collection Containers

These can be made using plastic 5-gallon pails with lids (press-fit or threaded for security) which are readily available, cheap and reusable

- ❖ Round 5 gallon pails are about 11" or 12 " diameter x 13" or 14" high
- ❖ Leave the handle on the pail for easy handling
- ❖ Cut a hole or slot in the lid large enough to allow people to put in a cell phone but not so large that people will be able to take phones out of the container (opening should be about 2"x 4")



Poster Or Label

- ❖ Download the poster from the PITCH-IN CANADA website (at www.nationalcellphonecollectionprogram.com and print it on good quality white paper (preferably in colour)
- ❖ Paste or tape the poster on the box or plastic pail

- ❖ Remember to include some contact information (your name, telephone number etc.) to let cell phone donors know the group or cause they are supporting and to provide them with a way to contact you for more information
